## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

Under current law, the crime of invasion of privacy is a Class A misdemeanor. This bill creates an additional crime of invasion of privacy for an individual who installs or uses a device to intentionally view under outer clothing another's genitals, pubic area, breast, or buttocks.

Prosecutors did not reach consensus on this bill. Some believe it will have little or no effect on the current workload; however, others believe that it will have an impact on their workload, particularly because a violation will be a felony. When dealing with felonies, prosecutors anticipate additional procedures (e.g. - preliminary hearings), which can be quite time-consuming. Due to a lack of consensus, a fiscal estimate is indeterminate.

## **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

For the reasons cited above, a long-term fiscal impact for this bill is indeterminate.
