## Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes several minor modifications to provisions that were created by 2013 Act 377, regarding the operation of implements of husbandry (IoH) and agricultural commercial motor vehicles (Ag CMVs) on Wisconsin roadways.

The bill extends the current axle weight exemption for certain types of IoH to Ag CMVs on non-state trunk highways. The bill maintains the ability of local governments to override this exemption by resolution or ordinance. The additional stresses, as a result of the axle weight exemption prescribed in the bill for Ag CMVs on local roadways, on bridges and pavement may diminish the service life or accelerate the deterioration of this infrastructure. However, the number of Ag CMVs, including their weight and axle spacing, that will be in operation under this increased axle weight allowance are unknown.
