Dear Chief Clerk Fuller:

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1008, relating to expunging a court record of certain offenses a person committed before he or she reached the age of 25.

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1009, relating to allowing a petition for expunging a court record of certain offenses ten years after completion of a sentence.

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1010, relating to imprisonment for nonpayment of forfeitures, costs, fees, or surcharges.

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1011, relating to extended out-of-home care to 21 years of age for persons who are completing secondary education, enrolled in postsecondary or vocational education, participating in an employment program or activity, employed at least part-time, or incapable of doing any of those activities due to a medical condition, providing an exemption from emergency rule procedures, providing an exemption from rule-making procedures, and granting rule-making authority.

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1012, relating to the right of a parent to have counsel in a proceeding for a child alleged to be in need of protection or services; the power of the juvenile court to appoint counsel in such a proceeding; granting rule-making authority; and making appropriations.

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1013, relating to a grant program for community prosecutors and making an appropriation.

Please add my name as a co-author of Assembly Bill 1017, relating to establishing college savings accounts for children born in this state and making an appropriation.
