2015 Wisconsin Act 74
[2015 Assembly Bill 205]

**Flashing Yellow Arrow Traffic
Control Signals**

BACKGROUND

Prior law did not specify the actions that vehicular traffic is permitted to take when facing a traffic control signal displaying a flashing yellow *arrow*. However, prior law, unchanged by 2015 Wisconsin Act 74, permitted vehicular traffic to enter an intersection with caution when facing a traffic control signal displaying a flashing yellow *signal*.

2015 WISCONSIN ACT 74

The Act clarifies that vehicular traffic facing a traffic control signal displaying a flashing yellow *arrow* may enter the intersection to make the movement indicated by the *arrow*, after yielding to other traffic lawfully in the intersection.

Effective date: The Act takes effect on November 13, 2015.
