Under prior law, two or more municipalities may enter into an intergovernmental cooperation agreement to create a multi-jurisdictional tax incremental district (TID), provided that the district contains territory in all municipalities included in the agreement, along with certain other requirements. However, prior law prohibits a town from participating in a multi-jurisdictional TID.

2015 Wisconsin Act 96 provides that a town that may otherwise create a TID under existing statutes may participate in a multi-jurisdictional TID.
