



WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 131
[2015 Assembly Bill 291]

Blaze Pink Hunting Clothing

Wisconsin law generally requires at least 50% of each article of a hunter's outer clothing above the waist, including a head covering, to be of a highly visible color commonly referred to as hunter orange, blaze orange, fluorescent orange, flame orange, or fluorescent blaze orange during times and in areas in which there is an open season for hunting deer with firearms.

2015 Wisconsin Act 131 allows hunters to wear the color commonly referred to as bright pink or fluorescent pink to satisfy this requirement.
