2015 Wisconsin Act 135 [2015 Assembly Bill 424]	Motor Carriers Operating in Intrastate Commerce

BACKGROUND

Under current law, motor carriers engaged in interstate commerce must operate under a motor carrier certificate of authority or license and must meet certain insurance requirements. Vehicle equipment and inspection laws also apply to motor carriers engaged in interstate commerce.

The Department of Transportation has rule-making authority relating to motor carriers engaged in interstate commerce.

2015 WISCONSIN ACT 135

The Act provides that the law relating to motor carriers engaged in interstate commerce, including rule-making authority, also applies to motor carriers engaged in intrastate commerce.
