

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 178 [2015 Assembly Bill 563]

Town Zoning in Dane County

2015 Wisconsin Act 178 does all of the following:

- Allows a town in Dane County to withdraw from coverage under the county zoning ordinance and the county development plan, and adopt a town zoning ordinance, under certain conditions, and sets limits on the nature of amendments that are allowed to be made to such an ordinance.
- Repeals the requirement that towns in Dane County obtain county board approval for adoption or amendment of a town zoning ordinance, and places requirements on Dane County with respect to the withdrawal of a town from coverage under the county zoning ordinance.
- Specifies that Dane County generally does not have authority to approve or object to a proposed plat or certified survey map if the subdivision or land is located in a town that has withdrawn from county zoning.
