2015 Wisconsin Act 189
[2015 Assembly Bill 680]

**Department of Military Affairs
Remedial Legislation**

2015 Wisconsin Act 189 is remedial legislation, introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee at the request of the Department of Military Affairs.

2013 Wisconsin Act 44 created an exception to certain statutes that prevent members of the National Guard on state active duty from being reimbursed for travel expenses in the same amount as an officer or enlisted member of equal rank in the corresponding branch of the U.S. Armed Forces.

Act 189 created an exception to another statute for members of the National Guard on state active duty. The exception applies to the prohibition against the Department of Administration approving for payment certain travel expenses exceeding the auto mileage rates set for state employees.

Effective date: Act 189 took effect on March 2, 2016.
