This legislation was prepared by the Legislative Reference Bureau (LRB) under s. 13.92 (1) (bm) 1. and 2. and (2) (L), Stats., and was introduced by the Joint Legislative Council's Law Revision Committee under s. 13.83 (1) (c) 2. and 5., Stats.

2015 Wisconsin Act 196 revises various provisions of the statutes to eliminate defects, anachronisms, and obsolete provisions. The Act makes the spelling of "optical disc" uniform throughout the statutes, replaces percentage signs with "percent," replaces "which" with "that" where grammatically appropriate, and inserts serial commas to conform with current drafting style. For additional information about the changes made by the Act, see the analysis and notes prepared by the LRB and included in the Act.

*Effective date:* Act 196 took effect on March 2, 2016.
