

WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

2015 Wisconsin Act 253 [2015 Senate Bill 97]

Including Household Pets in Certain Orders and Injunctions

2015 Wisconsin Act 253 provides that when a judge or circuit court commissioner issues a domestic abuse, child abuse, individual-at-risk, or harassment temporary restraining order or injunction, the judge or circuit court commissioner may order the respondent not to remove, hide, damage, harm, or mistreat, or dispose of a household pet. The Act further provides that the judge or circuit court commissioner may order the respondent to allow the petitioner or a family member or household member of the petitioner acting on his or her behalf to retrieve a household pet.
