



## WISCONSIN LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ACT MEMO

**2015 Wisconsin Act 305**  
[2015 Assembly Bill 824]

**Sparsity Aid**

2015 Wisconsin Act 305 allows school districts that qualified for sparsity aid in the previous year, but no longer qualify because they exceeded the 725 student limit this year, to receive any sparsity aid funds that are left over after qualifying districts receive sparsity aid. The Act also increases the student enrollment cap for receiving sparsity aid from 725 students to 745 students.

*Effective date:* April 1, 2016. The student enrollment cap increase first applies to eligibility for sparsity aid in the 2016-17 school year.
