2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 602

Current law requires private schools to obtain accreditation to qualify to participate in the parental choice programs or the new special needs scholarship program. The law lists accrediting agencies that can qualify a school to participate in these programs. Assembly Bill 602 adds Christian Schools International to the list of accrediting agencies.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 adds another entity to the above list of accrediting agencies, Association of Christian Schools International.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representatives Katsma and Schraa on January 6, 2016. On January 14, 2016, the Assembly Committee on Education recommended adoption of the amendment, and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 11; Noes, 5.
