2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 664

Under current rules promulgated by the Department of Health Services (DHS), in order to provide mental health services at a school, a provider must designate the school site as a clinic office. Assembly Bill 664 abolishes this requirement.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Amendment 1 requires DHS to provide reimbursement under the Medical Assistance program to licensed treatment professionals for mental health services provided at a school, to the extent federal law allows such reimbursement, regardless of whether the school site is designated as a clinic office and regardless of whether the licensed treatment professional is employed by, a contractor of, or affiliated with a clinic.

BILL HISTORY

Assembly Amendment 1 was offered by Representative Tittl on February 16, 2016. The Assembly adopted the amendment on a voice vote, then passed the bill, as amended, on a voice vote.
