2015 Assembly Bill 744 requires institutions of higher education in Wisconsin that offer associates degrees or higher to annually provide a letter to each student that contains specific information regarding the individual student's cost of education, loans, and total debt.

ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2

Assembly Amendment 2 provides that the letters are only required to include private loan information to the extent that private loan information is received by an institution of higher education from a private lender or loan servicer.

BILL HISTORY

On February 16, 2016, the Assembly voted to adopt Assembly Amendment 2 on a voice vote and passed the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 61; Noes, 36; and Paired, 2.
