### **2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 771**

Assembly Bill 771 requires the Department of Justice (DOJ) to award grants for drug law enforcement and interdiction services to the Lafayette County Sheriff's Department in the amount of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2015-16 and in the amount of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2016-17.

### **ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 2**

Assembly Amendment 2 decreases the amount of the grant for fiscal year 2015-16. Specifically, under the amendment, DOJ must award grants for drug law enforcement and interdiction services to the Lafayette County Sheriff's Department in the amount of **\$20,000 in fiscal year 2015-16** and in the amount of \$50,000 in fiscal year 2016-17.

### **BILL HISTORY**

On February 4, 2016, the Joint Committee on Finance offered Assembly Amendment 2. On that same date, the Joint Committee on Finance recommended: (1) adoption of the amendment on a vote of Ayes, 12; Noes, 3; and (2) passage of the bill, as amended, on a vote of Ayes, 13; Noes, 2.
