# **Assembly Amendment 1**

#### **2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 790**

The bill requires the Department of Health Services (DHS) to award grants in the amount of \$250,000 in the fiscal year 2016-17 to counties or regions of counties for their mobile crisis teams to obtain training on recognizing and serving individuals with dementia.

## ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 1

The amendment clarifies that the \$250,000 grant is made on a one-time basis in fiscal year 2016-17. The amendment also provides that, when DHS submits information for the purposes of the 2017-19 Biennial Budget, DHS should submit information concerning the appropriation made under the bill as though the increase to that appropriation had not been made.

## **BILL HISTORY**

Assembly Amendment 1 was introduced by the Joint Committee on Finance on February 4, 2016. On the same day, the Joint Committee on Finance recommended adoption of Assembly Amendment 1 and passage of the bill, as amended, on votes of Ayes, 15; Noes 0.
