2015 ASSEMBLY BILL 866

Assembly Bill 866 allows a pharmacist to dispense prescribed drugs in quantities and fills that vary from the quantities and fills specified in a prescription order, unless the prescriber specifies that adherence to the prescription order is medically necessary.

ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 1

Assembly Substitute Amendment 1 (ASA 1) specifies that the provisions described above do not apply with respect to controlled substances and do not allow a pharmacist to dispense more than a 90-day supply of a drug in a single fill or refill.

BILL HISTORY

On February 18, 2016, the Assembly adopted ASA 1, and passed the bill, as amended, on voice votes.
