2015 SENATE BILL 266

The bill permits a local governmental unit to repeal its comprehensive plan and eliminates the requirement that ordinances must be consistent with a local comprehensive plan if no plan is in effect. The bill also eliminates the defunct comprehensive planning grant program.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

The amendment deletes the lapse for the inactive comprehensive planning grant program, preserving the current status of the land information fund.

BILL HISTORY

On November 18, 2015, the Senate Committee on Government Operations and Consumer Protection recommended Senate Amendment 1 for adoption by a vote of Ayes, 5; Noes, 0. The committee then recommended the passage of Senate Bill 266, as amended, by a vote of Ayes, 3; Noes, 2.
