2015 SENATE BILL 697

2015 Senate Bill 697 prohibits, with certain specified exceptions, the access, collection or transfer of information stored on an event data recorder (EDR) installed in a motor vehicle, unless the intended use is disclosed to the owner and the owner provides written consent. The bill also prohibits certain specified practices by motor vehicle insurers based on their access to EDR data.

SENATE AMENDMENT 1

Senate Amendment 1 eliminates the specified prohibited practices in regard to insurance company use of EDR data. The general prohibition on the use of EDR data without written permission is retained.

BILL HISTORY

The Senate Committee on Government Operations and Consumer Protection unanimously recommended the adoption of Senate Amendment 1 and the passage of 2015 Senate Bill 697, as amended, on February 10, 2016.
