Attached are the proposed changes the bureau has prepared for the Law Revision Committee. These changes are primarily based on the inquiries that charitable staff receive from licensees and others that have difficulty interpreting current statute language. These changes will not have a fiscal effect and are merely to provide more clarity to the statute language as it currently exists.

**Law Revision Committee Proposed Changes – Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 563
Submitted by: Division of Gaming-Office of Charitable Gaming**

§563.03 Definitions. In this chapter:

(4e) “Calendar” means a ~~tabular~~ table or register of days covering not less than one nor more than 12 calendar months that entitles the purchaser to one entry in each drawing in a calendar raffle.

(4m) “Calendar raffle” means a raffle for which a drawing is held and a prize awarded on each date specified on ~~in~~ a calendar as a date upon which a prize will be awarded.

Specific Statutory Change	Please see above.
Administrative Problem:	Charitable staff field many questions regarding what a “tabular register of days” is and the definition of a “Calendar Raffle” as described in the current statute.
The Need for the Change:	Provides clarity to the meaning of the definition and will reduce staff time fielding inquiries from licensees.
Fiscal Effect:	No Fiscal Impact.

§563.13 Affidavits and fees. Except as provided in s. 563.135, an application for a license to conduct bingo shall be accompanied by:

(4) A \$10 license fee for each bingo occasion proposed to be conducted and \$5 for an annual license fee for ~~each~~ the designated member responsible for the proper utilization of gross receipts.

AND

§563.61 Report of bingo operations. (1) Each licensed organization shall file with the department a report . . . The report shall include:

(a) The name and address of each supervising member and ~~each~~ the member responsible for the proper utilization of gross receipts.

Specific Statutory Change	Please see above.
Administrative Problem:	Sections 563.12(9) and 563.13(2), Stats., reference only one member being designated the person responsible for the proper use of bingo funds.
The Need for the Change:	Changing the word “each” to “the” in both the above sections provides consistency with Sections 563.12(9) and 563.13(2).
Fiscal Effect:	No Fiscal Impact.

§563.51 Restrictions on the conduct of bingo

(22)(b) Method of play. The objects to be drawn shall be essentially the same in size, ~~color~~, shape, weight, balance and all other characteristics, so that at all times during the conduct of bingo, each object possesses the capacity for equal agitation with any other object within the receptacle.

Specific Statutory Change	Please see above.
Administrative Problem:	Organizations would like to use sets of bingo balls that are multi-colored because they are of a much higher quality than the all-white sets commonly used. The multi-colored balls are sturdier and the numbers and letters are printed on the inside so they don’t wear off. The color of the bingo balls has no impact on their ability to agitate equally, as long as all other characteristics are the same.
The Need for the Change:	This change would allow the bingo licensees to use multi colored balls which is the current practice. All-White sets are inferior quality, not durable and are becoming obsolete.
Fiscal Effect:	No Fiscal Impact.

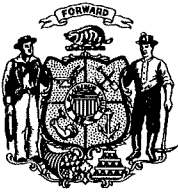

Administrative Problem:	Current language in (1m) above is confusing to licensees and is not consistent with other statute language in §563.93(2g)(a) which reads “Prominently display, at each place where tickets may be purchased, a notice describing any state or federal law that imposes an age restriction on who may possess a prize that will be awarded in the raffle.” This change will provide uniformity across the entire statute.
The Need for the Change:	This change will provide uniformity across the entire statute. Additionally, it will reduce charitable staff time explaining the meaning behind the current definition.
Fiscal Effect:	No Fiscal Impact.

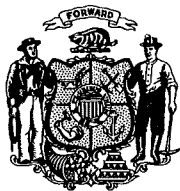
