ETF Proposed Legislation for Law Revision Committee

6. Because of Increased Flexibility Available with the ETF Benefits Administration System, Eliminate Time Requirements for Acceptance of Retirement Applications 40.23(1)(c).

Rationale for Change: 40.23(1)(c) requires that a retirement application that specifies an annuity date later than 60 days after receipt by ETF will not be accepted, unless the member is at an age where a required minimum distribution is due. As part of the implementation of the new benefits administration system, ETF would like to remove this limitation from statute. The new benefits administration system will provide ETF flexibility to adjust the time limit to align with the capabilities of the new system and business needs.

Recommended Change:
