-An amendment that restores the annual meeting or referendum requirement to opt out.

-An amendment that restores the town's requirement to maintain a map

 -An amendment that would grandfather in towns who have already initiated the opt out process to maintain the process under current law.

-An amendment that would require a town, in the opt out process, to print notice in print media at least 2 times in the 30 days before an opt-out of zoning annual meeting/special meeting/referendum.
