- An amendment that restores the annual meeting or referendum requirement to opt out.
- An amendment that restores the town's requirement to maintain a map
- An amendment that would grandfather in towns who have already initiated the opt out process to maintain the process under current law.
-  -An amendment that would require a town, in the opt out process, to print notice in print media at least 2 times in the 30 days before an opt-out of zoning annual meeting/special meeting/referendum.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 1. Page 2, line 17: delete that line and substitute:

3 "SECTION 4m. 60.23 (34) (b) 3. of the statutes is amended to read:

4 ~~X~~ 60.23 (34) (b) 3. The ordinance enacted under par. (a) is approved either at the

5 annual town meeting or in a referendum called by the town board for that purpose

6 at the next spring or general election, to be held not sooner than 70 days after the

7 referendum is called by the town board. Beginning 30 days before the annual town

8 meeting or a referendum is held as described under this subdivision, the town shall

9 publish a class 2 notice under ch. 985 to provide notice to area residents. To the

10 greatest extent possible, one of the notices shall be published in the official state

11 newspaper, and one of the notices shall be published in the local newspaper that is

12 most likely to give residents of the town notice of the meeting or referendum."
