1 **AN ACT to repeal** 106.273 (3) (b); **to renumber and amend** 106.273 (3) (a)
2 (intro.), 106.273 (3) (a) 1. and 106.273 (3) (a) 2.; **to amend** 20.445 (1) (b) and
3 20.445 (1) (bm); and **to create** 20.445 (1) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** career
4 and technical education incentive grants and making an appropriation.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill removes the per pupil limitation on career and technical education incentive grants that the Department of Workforce Development awards to school districts. Under current law, DWD must award a grant to a school district in the amount of \$1,000 per pupil who, in the prior school year, obtained a high school diploma and successfully completed an industry-recognized certification program approved by DWD. Under the bill, DWD must award \$1,000 for each certification program completed by a pupil. The bill also changes the funding of the program from a sum certain to a sum sufficient.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

5 **SECTION 1.** 20.445 (1) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

19 **SECTION 4.** 106.273 (3) (a) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 106.273 (3)

9 **SECTION 6.** 106.273 (3) (a) 2. of the statutes is renumbered 106.273 (3) (bm) and
10 amended to read:

11 106.273 (3) (bm) The pupil successfully completed the school district's
12 ~~industry-recognized certification program under subd. 1.~~ in any a school year in
13 which the program was approved by the department under sub. (2).

14 **SECTION 7.** 106.273 (3) (b) of the statutes is repealed.

15 **SECTION 8. Initial applicability.**

16 (1) CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION INCENTIVE GRANTS. This act first applies
17 to an award to a school district for completion of an industry-recognized certification
18 program by a pupil in the 2017-18 school year.

19 **SECTION 9. Effective date.**

20 (1) CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION INCENTIVE GRANTS. This act takes effect on
21 the day after publication, or on the 2nd day after publication of the 2017 biennial
22 budget act, whichever is later.
