This bill prohibits certain mental health providers from engaging in conversion therapy with a minor. Conversion therapy is any practice that seeks to change an individual's sexual orientation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

As such, would it be possible to make the following changes:

Page 1. Lines 6-7

... individual's sexual orientation, behaviors related to sexual orientation, or gender identity, or therapy to eliminate or reduce sexual or romantic attractions or feelings towards individuals of the same sex.

This could in turn change the analysis to state: "Conversion therapy is any practice that seeks to change an individual's sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression.
