Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill makes a third or subsequent violation of patronizing a prostitute a Class I felony. Under the bill, a first or second violation remains a Class A misdemeanor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

4 **SECTION 1.** 944.31 of the statutes is renumbered 944.31 (intro.) and amended

6 **944.31 Patronizing prostitutes.** (intro.) Any person who enters or remains
7 in any place of prostitution with intent to have nonmarital sexual intercourse or to
8 commit an act of sexual gratification, in public or in private, involving the sex organ
