Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill changes the penalty for the crime of patronizing a prostitute from a Class A misdemeanor to a Class I felony if the person has been previously convicted of that crime at least two times.

The Criminal Appeals Unit within the Department of Justice represents the state in all felony appeals before the Wisconsin Court of Appeals, the Wisconsin Supreme Court and the United States Supreme Court. Any potential change to criminal penalties could increase or decrease the number of felony appeals. The magnitude of the potential change is unknown.
