Jackie:

There is an issuing fee of 75 cents for all fishing licenses, which is why the total fee under current law for the licenses mentioned in the draft is \$6.25 instead of \$7, and why the new fee is \$4.25 instead of \$5.

I believe you said that the draft should reduce the fee for those between 65 and 90 years of age. However, under current law, the reduced senior citizen fee for fishing licenses is for those residents 65 and older. Therefore, I assumed that the draft should simply change this fee.
