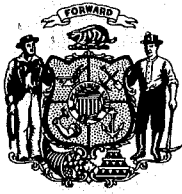

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposal extends a reduced license fee to annual fishing licenses sold to resident youth who are 16-17 years old and to resident seniors who are 65 year old or older. Currently, the license fee established by statute for residents 16 or 17 year old or residents 65 and older is \$6.25. This bill would decrease the annual fishing license fee to \$4.25 if the annual fishing license is issued to a resident who has not received that type of approval, or been conferred the privileges of that type of approval, in any of the ten years preceding the date of application.

Revenue is expected to decrease by \$2 for each annual fishing license sold to a resident 16 or 17 years old or 65 years of age or older who otherwise would have purchased an annual fishing license at the \$6.25 rate currently established in statute for these resident age groups.

During the license years 2014 through 2016, the department sold an average 32,462 annual fishing licenses to resident youth 16-17 years of age and 126,021 annual fishing licenses to resident seniors 65 years of age and older. However, the fiscal effect of the proposal is indeterminate since it is difficult to estimate the number of individuals in those age groups that have not purchased a license within the last 10 years but would choose to do so under the reduced rate.
