July 19, 2007 – Introduced by Representatives PETROWSKI, KAUFERT, KESTELL, LOTHIAN, LEMAHIEU, A. OTT, NELSON, PETERSEN, SEIDEL and VAN ROY, cosponsored by Senators PLALE, BRESKE, A. LASEE and LAZICH. Referred to Committee on State Affairs.

1 AN ACT *to create* 100.20 (2) (c) of the statutes; **relating to:** the provision of
2 coin-operated soda water vending machines to retail food establishments.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (DATCP) to promulgate rules prohibiting methods of competition and trade practices that it determines are unfair. Using this authority, DATCP has promulgated a rule regulating the provision of equipment by soda wholesalers to retailers.

This bill prohibits DATCP from regulating the provision of coin-operated vending machines by soda wholesalers to certain retailers, such as grocery stores.
