Hi Melinda,

Rep. Taylor would like to draft a bill that requires DOJ to publish a separate annual report on each of the following topics: sexual assault, domestic violence, and human trafficking.

Wis. Stat. § 968.075(9) requires district attorneys to submit domestic violence statistics to the DOJ annually, but does not require DOJ to publish a report. Wis. Stat. § 165.845 requires DOJ to collect certain types of crime data, including data requested by the FBI under its UCR program (the UCR program asks for data on sexual assault, domestic violence, and human trafficking).

Hi Melinda,

Rep. Taylor has a few edits to LRB 1941/2:

- Change references to domestic violence to domestic “abuse”
- Page 1, Lines 6-7: Change reporting requirement to include the information on sexual assault collected under 165.845(1)(a) (which is what is in the current draft) and information on domestic abuse collected under **968.075(9)** (rather than having domestic abuse under 165.845)
- Page 1, Line 7: Change “crimes committed” to “cases reported”
- Page 2, Line 4: Add “as available” to the end of the sentence
- Page 2, Line 6: Add “as available” to the end of the sentence
- Page 2, Line 7: Add “for the reported incidents” after “When available”
- Page 2, Line 9: Delete “committed” and add “or charges reported”
- Page 2, Line 10: Delete “crimes” and substitute “offenses or charges” and change “committed” to “reported”

If we could have a revised draft at some point early in the week of 7/10, that would be great – Have a good holiday weekend!
