- draft a bill that provides a grant to the National Farm Medicine Center at the Marshfield Clinic for reimbursing the costs of obtaining rollover protective structures for farm tractors
- appropriate \$250K from the agricultural management fund
- cross-reference def. of "farm tractor" in § 340.01(16)
- require that at least 70% of the grant funds must be used for reimbursing costs of rollover protective systems
- the tractor owner pays 30%, up to a limit of \$500, of the cost of an RPS, and NFMC reimburses the rest of the cost
- require NFMC to report annually to DATCP on use of the funds

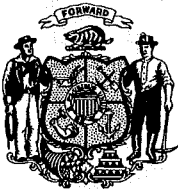

"Rollover protective structure" means a structure that meets national or international safety standards installed on a farm tractor

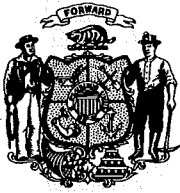

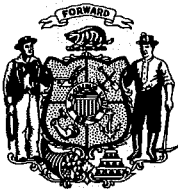
