### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill makes changes to the Address Confidentiality Program administered by the Department of Justice, including authorizing the department to promulgate rules allowing participants to consent to disclose address information for specific purposes; authorizing the department to disenroll participants who no longer meet eligibility criteria; and permitting the department act as the registered agent for a single member LLC.

The costs associated with implementing these changes are not anticipated to be significant and can be absorbed within existing resources.
