***Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau***

This bill allows a school board to go into closed session for the purpose of discussing, developing, reviewing, or approving a school safety plan. Under current law, a school board is required to meet in open session for these purposes. Open session is a meeting that is held in a place reasonably accessible to members of the public and open to all citizens at all times.

***The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:***

3 SECTION 1. 19.85 (1) (i) of the statutes is created to read:  
4 19.85 (1) (i) For a school board to discuss, develop, review, or approve a school  
5 safety plan under s. 118.07 (4).

Fern,

Thank you for all the work that you've done drafting our bill package last week. I've reviewed the drafts and have a few things to add, but in general we would like the following bills prepared for introduction:

**LRB-5633** – Expand categorical aid funding for school mental health staff

**LRB-5634** – Increase community and school collaborative mental health grants

**LRB-5635** – Expands statewide training for school staff and community partners around mental health screening and interventions.

\*\*\*In reference to your drafting notes we would like the total amount appropriated to be \$1.42 million. I did some digging and apparently ACT 31 (2017) appropriated an additional \$200,000 for SBIRT, in addition to the \$220k that you had indicated. We would like the additional \$1m on top of that \$420k.

**LRB-5636** – Establishes a Wisconsin School Safety Center

\*\*\*Drafting Note 1 – would like to appropriate money the 17-18 fiscal year. I'm not sure how this works as, we are halfway through, but whatever makes most sense from a drafting perspective (proration/full amount) works for us. Continuing appropriation

\*\*\*Drafting Note 2 – The inclusion of independent charter schools in entities that may receive assistance from the WSSC is fine with us.

**LRB-5637** – Creates new "Violence prevention and reduction" grants as a categorical aid (\$24 million annually).

\*\*\*We would like the authorization of DPI to promulgate rules in regards to providing trainings with local community or law enforcement partners.

**LRB-5640** – Allows school boards to go into closed session to address school safety plans

\*\*\*The School safety plans should also be exempt from open records law.

**LRB-5648** – Requires school boards and governing body of a private school establish a school safety team and a school safety plan. Also requires comprehensive security site assessment.

**LRB-5655** – WISH appropriation

\$1 million to create Wisconsin Safe and Healthy Schools Center

Again, once these changes are made, we'd like the drafts prepared for introduction as soon as possible. Noon tomorrow would be amazing, but of course we understand if this isn't possible. Please feel free to give me a call if you need clarification on any of these items. Thank you again for your help and time.

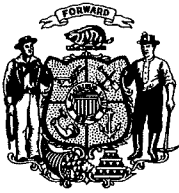
