Description creating an Interagency Council on Homelessness and making an appropriation					

Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

This bill creates the Interagency Council on Homelessness, of which the state superintendent of public instruction or his or her designee is a member. The primary responsibilities of the Council include establishing and periodically reviewing a statewide policy for ending and preventing homelessness; designating individuals from state agencies to implement the policy of the council; and implementing the policy in cooperation with state agencies.

State: This bill creates an appropriation under Ch. 20 that allocates to the Department of Administration \$95,000 in FY18 and FY19 to fund Council operations. This bill affects neither DPI's Ch. 20 appropriations nor local school districts. Rather, the only effect on DPI will be that the state superintendent of public instruction (or his or her designee) will dedicate some time to the Council for its quarterly meetings.

Local: no fiscal impact.
