Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Under this proposal, ongoing administrative efforts from DMV Revenue Accounting would require 72 purchase orders created annually, or 24 hours of additional work. Annual reconciliation payments for all counties would require an additional 120 hours of work. The job classification is Accountant Journey and the average compensation is \$31.91 an hour including fringe benefits.

To implement this bill, a new automated revenue accounting monthly report would need to be programmed to identify the special plate revenue collected for each individual county. The project is estimated to take between two to three months to implement with a total one-time development cost of \$36,360.

Long-Range Fiscal Implications

Ongoing WisDOT salary costs to administer county payments are estimated at \$4,595 annually.
