## The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 175.60 (15) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 175.60 (15) (a) (intro.)
and amended to read:
175.60 (15) (a) (intro.) Except as provided in par. (e) and sub. (9r) (b), or unless
the license is suspended or revoked under sub. (14), a license initially issued under
this section is valid for a period of 5 years from the date on which the license is issued
unless the license is suspended or revoked under sub. (14). and a license renewed
under this section is valid as follows:

1	<b>SECTION 2.</b> 175.60 (15) (a) 1. and 2. of the statutes are created to read:
2	175.60 (15) (a) 1. If the license is renewed under this section before or on the
3	expiration date of the license being renewed, the license is valid for 5 years from the
4	expiration date of the license being renewed.
5	2. If the license is renewed under this section after the expiration date of the
6	license being renewed, the license is valid for 5 years from the date of renewal.
7	SECTION 3. Initial applicability.

8 (1) This act first applies to a license renewed on the effective date of this9 subsection.
