**SENATE AMENDMENT 1,  
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 25**

May 10, 2017 - Offered by Senators JOHNSON, VINEHOUT, L. TAYLOR, HANSEN, WIRCH,  
BEWLEY, SHILLING, MILLER, RINGHAND, RISSER, CARPENTER and ERPENBACH.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 16: after that line insert:

3 “SECTION 4m. 103.24 of the statutes is amended to read:

4 **103.24 Hours of work.** The department shall determine and fix reasonable  
5 hours of employment for minors under 16 years of age in street trades. Except as  
6 provided in this section, the department may not fix hours of employment for minors  
7 under 16 years of age in street trades that exceed the maximum hours per day and  
8 per week specified in s. 103.68 (2) (a) and (b), that exceed the maximum days per  
9 week specified in s. 103.68 (2) (c), or that begin earlier or end later than the hours  
10 specified in s. 103.68 (2) (d) and (e). The department may not limit the hours of  
11 employment for minors 16 years of age or over in street trades or the hours of  
12 employment for minors of any age who are engaged in the delivery of newspapers to  
13 the consumer.”

1           **2.** Page 4, line 3: after that line insert:

2           “**SECTION 9c.** 103.65 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

3           103.65 (2) No minor ~~under 16 years of age~~ may be employed or permitted to  
4 work at any employment for such hours of the day or week, for such days of the week,  
5 or at such periods of the day as may be dangerous or prejudicial to the life, health,  
6 safety, or welfare of the minor.

7           **SECTION 9g.** 103.66 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

8           103.66 (2) The department may investigate and fix reasonable classifications  
9 of employments and hours of employment for minors ~~under 16 years of age~~ and may  
10 issue general or special orders fixing ~~for those minors~~ maximum hours of  
11 employment for minors per day and per week, maximum days of employment per  
12 week, hours at which employment may begin and end, and the duration of lunch and  
13 other rest periods as are necessary to protect the life, health, safety, and welfare of  
14 those minors. ~~For minors under 16 years of age, the department may not fix hours~~  
15 ~~of employment that exceed the maximum hours per day and per week specified in s.~~  
16 ~~103.68 (2) (a) and (b), that exceed the maximum days per week specified in s. 103.68~~  
17 ~~(2) (c), or that begin earlier or end later than the hours specified in s. 103.68 (2) (d)~~  
18 ~~and (e). For minors 16 years of age or over, the department may fix the duration of~~  
19 ~~lunch and other rest periods, but may not limit hours of employment or issue general~~  
20 ~~or special orders fixing maximum hours of employment per day or per week,~~  
21 ~~maximum days of employment per week, or hours at which employment may begin~~  
22 ~~and end.~~

23           **SECTION 9n.** 103.68 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

1           103.68 (1) No minor may be employed or permitted to work at any gainful  
2 occupation other than domestic service, farm labor, or service as an election inspector  
3 under s. 7.30 (2) (am) for more than 8 hours in any one day nor more than 40 hours  
4 nor more than 6 days in any one week, nor during such hours as the minor is required  
5 under s. 118.15 to attend school.

6           **SECTION 9r.** 103.68 (2) (intro.) of the statutes is renumbered 103.68 (2) and  
7 amended to read:

8           103.68 (2) No minor under 16 years of age may be employed or permitted to  
9 work in any gainful occupation, other than domestic service or farm labor more than  
10 24 hours in any one week, nor, except in domestic service, farm labor, or public  
11 exhibitions, as provided in s. 103.78, ~~as follows:~~ or in street trades, as defined in s.  
12 103.21 (6), before 7 a.m. nor after 6 p.m.

13           **SECTION 9w.** 103.68 (2) (a) to (e) of the statutes are repealed.”.
