3 Medicaid expansion and eligibility for BadgerCare Plus and BadgerCare Plus Core,
4 alcohol and other drug abuse prevention and treatment, and making
5 appropriations".

6 **2.** Page ² 1, line ⁴ 3 before that line insert:

7 "SECTION 1c. 20.005 (3) (schedule) of the statutes: at the appropriate place,
8 insert the following amounts for the purposes indicated:

4 ³~~SECTION 10k.~~ 49.471 (4g) of the statutes is created to read:

5 49.471 (4g) MEDICAID EXPANSION; FEDERAL MEDICAL ASSISTANCE PERCENTAGE. (a)
6 For services provided to individuals described under sub. (4) (a) 4. and s. 49.45 (23),
7 the department shall comply with all federal requirements to qualify for the highest
8 available enhanced federal medical assistance percentage. The department shall
9 submit any amendment to the state medical assistance plan, request for a waiver of
10 federal Medicaid law, or other approval request required by the federal government
11 to provide services to the individuals described under sub. (4) (a) 4. and s. 49.45 (23)
12 and qualify for the highest available enhanced federal medical assistance
13 percentage.

14 (b) If the department does not qualify for an enhanced federal medical
15 assistance percentage, or if the enhanced federal medical assistance percentage
16 obtained by the department is lower than printed in federal law as of July 1, 2013,
17 for individuals eligible under sub. (4) (a) 4. or s. 49.45 (23), the department shall
18 submit to the joint committee on finance a fiscal analysis comparing the cost to
19 maintain coverage for adults who are not pregnant and not elderly with family
20 incomes up to 133 percent of the poverty line to the cost of limiting eligibility to those
21 adults with family incomes up to 100 percent of the poverty line. The department
22 may reduce income eligibility for adults who are not pregnant and not elderly from
23 family incomes of up to 133 percent of the poverty line to family incomes of up to 100
24 percent of the poverty line only if this reduction in income eligibility levels is
25 approved by the joint committee on finance.

1 SECTION 1m. 51.03 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

2 51.03 (7) From the appropriation under s. 20.435 (5) (bd), the department shall
3 allocate to programs providing prevention, intervention, or treatment for alcohol and
4 other drug abuse in each fiscal year an amount equal to 10 percent of the savings,
5 as determined by the department, in general purpose revenue by expanding the
6 Medical Assistance program to certain adults with family incomes up to 133 percent
7 of the federal poverty line under 2017 Wisconsin Act (this act)."

8 3. Page 2, line 14: after that line insert:

9 "(2m) MEDICAID EXPANSION. In the schedule under section 20.005 (3) of the
10 statutes for the appropriation to the department of health services under section
11 20.435 (4) (b) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2017-18 is decreased
12 by \$108,200,000 to provide Medical Assistance to certain adults with family incomes
13 up to 133 percent of the federal poverty line. In the schedule under section 20.005
14 (3) of the statutes for the appropriation to the department of health services under
15 section 20.435 (4) (b) of the statutes, the dollar amount for fiscal year 2018-19 is
16 decreased by \$236,900,000 to provide Medical Assistance to certain adults with
17 family incomes up to 133 percent of the federal poverty line. "

18 SECTION 3m. Effective dates. This act takes effect on the day after
19 publication, except as follows:

20 2m (1) MEDICAID EXPANSION. The treatment of sections 20.435 (5) (bd), 49.45 (23)
21 (a), 49.471 (1) (cr), (4) (a) 4. b., and (4g), and 51.03 (7) of the statutes and SECTIONS
22 1c and 2 (2m) of this act take effect on January 1, 2018, or on the day after publication,
23 whichever is later."
