Current law grants immunity from prosecution for possessing a controlled substance or controlled substance analog to a person (aider) who brings another person to an emergency room or other health facility, who summons police or emergency medical assistance, or who administers aid to another person because the aider believes the other person is suffering from an overdose or other adverse reaction to a controlled substance or a controlled substance analog.

This bill grants the same immunity to the aided person and also grants the aider and the aided person immunity from having their probation, parole, or extended supervision revoked under the circumstances that led the aider to summon or provide emergency assistance.
