

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows: $\mathbf{2}$ 1. Page 2, line 4: delete "The" and substitute "The Except as provided in subd. 3 3., the". 2. Page 3, line 4: after that line insert: 4 "Section 2m. 196.378 (3) (a) 3. of the statutes is created to read: 5 6 196.378 (3) (a) 3. If an electric provider has satisfied the provider's renewable 7 energy percentage required under sub. (2) (a) 2., the provider may not create a 8 renewable resource credit under subd. 1m. using heat as described under sub. (1) (h) 1. k. or heat that is a byproduct of a manufacturing process and is used to provide 9 10 thermal energy for another purpose.".
