Thanks for all the hard work so far guys. I have 2 additions to make and one small change. I'll try and match them up with the assigned groups, but I included everyone in case I get the subject area wrong.

Additions:

- 1) An amendment that would add \$20 mil. into the next budget for the DWD Fastforward program for worker training specifically targeting training for high tech manufacturing jobs. (Was this Michael Duchek??)
- 2) An amendment that would add another position to DOA (in addition to the position added in the bill) that would be focused on outreach to local economic development groups/boards. This position would not be as "high up" the salary range as the one in the bill. I don't really know the levels that well, but let's say somewhere in the 60-85k dollar range. (Michael Gallagher??)

Change:

- 1) On the Transportation Bonding Amendment: take out the dollar-for-dollar match language, so it goes back to its original "any federal match" concept. But give JFC oversight of the whole \$250k in bonding. (Zachary Wyatt??)

We will produce one technical amendment which will include all the items from the documents called "Amendments in Drafting" and "Technical Amendments from Assembly/Leg. Council." The LRB # is a0891

With regard to the first document, here are the assignments, based on the numbering in that document:

- 1) Bond counsel's concerns, moral obligation pledge, Mike.
- 2) 12% TIF cap language, Marc.

- 5) WEDC to verify credit eligibility, instead of electric utility, Mark
- 6) DOA to determine if an expenditure outside a TID "benefits the district", Marc
- 7) Same as DOA #6, no drafting for this item

Local concerns: These will be individual amendments.

- 1) State tax exemption for local government obligations, Joe
- 2) County may issue sales tax revenue bonds, Marc
- 3) Tax increments may be distributed to a county to pay county debt service, Marc

- 4) Water and sewer extension financing. This will be Marc, but there aren't really drafting instructions, just a comment stating that "This framework would benefit from reconsideration and expansion."
- e) Additional project costs, Marc
- f) Expenditure period extended until end of TID's life, Marc

- 1) Wetlands, Zack
- 2) DNR oversight issues, Zack
