"SECTION 55L. 281.346 (1) (pm) of the statutes is amended to read:

281.346 (1) (pm) "Public water supply" means water distributed to the public through a physically connected system of treatment, storage, and distribution facilities that serve a group of largely residential customers and that may also serve industrial, commercial, and other institutional customers and includes water withdrawn directly from the Great Lakes basin and through such a system.

SECTION 55m. 281.346 (2) (c) of the statutes is renumbered 281.346 (2) (c) 1.

SECTION 55n. 281.346 (2) (c) 2. of the statutes is created to read:

281.346 (2) (c) 2. If a person operating a public water supply system also operates a public wastewater system, the water loss from consumptive use of a
