**Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

2017 AB 234 would create the Interagency Council on Homelessness. The Council would review and establish a statewide policy with the purpose of preventing and ending homelessness, designate staff from the Council's member agencies to coordinate the implementation of the policies established by the Council and report at least annually to the Governor and the houses of the Legislature on the activities of the Council. The Council would consist of various members, as specified by the bill under s. 15.107, Wis. Stats. (e.g., the Secretary of various state agencies involved in homelessness activities, or their designee; a representative from each of four organizations involved in activities addressing homelessness).

2017 AB 234 provides 1.0 FTE GPR-funded position, and \$95,000 in annual GPR expenditure authority in an appropriation under 20.505 (4) (f), Stats., created by the proposed legislation. The position would serve as the director of the Council, providing for the coordination and administration of Council activities.

The Department's Supportive Housing unit currently administers several homelessness and special needs programs funded by federal and state resources (e.g., the Emergency Solutions Grant/ Transitional Housing Program/ Homelessness Prevention Program (ETH); the State Shelter Subsidy Grant Program for emergency homeless shelters). The staff responsible for the administration of these programs could potentially be designated by the Council as the Department's agency staff to provide for the implementation of the Council's proposals, as required under 2017 AB 234. This workload could be absorbed within existing resources. Note that this workload is in addition to the workload associated with the administration of the Council that would be provided for by the director position included in the proposed legislation.
