The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

7	SECTION 1d. 454.06 (8) of the statutes is amended to read:
8	454.06 (8) EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL. The renewal date for licenses issued under
9	subs. (2) to (6) is specified under s. 440.08 (2) (a), and the renewal fees for such
10	licenses are determined by the department under s. 440.03 (9) (a). The examining

23	another jurisdiction, and is not a party to a proceeding before the licensing agency
24	in which it is alleged that the applicant was negligent in the licensed practice or
25	violated the law relating to the licensed practice.

20	454.27 (1) (a) The applicant has at least 4,000 hours of experience in licensed
21	practice <u>completes a one-hour course educating the applicant on statutes and rules</u>
22	that apply to the practice, has never been disciplined by the licensing authority of
23	another jurisdiction, and is not a party to a proceeding before the licensing agency
