1. Page 1, line 3: on lines 3 and 4, delete "(u)" and substitute "(v)".

****NOTE: 2017 Wisconsin Act 8 created paragraph (u).

2. Page 1, line 9: delete "and pastry, and herb" and substitute "pastry, and dairy product, and herb".

****NOTE: 2017 Wisconsin Act 8 created the state dairy product. This item reconciles Senate Bill 248 and 2017 Wisconsin Act 8.

May 11, 2017 - Introduced by Senators PETROWSKI and COWLES, cosponsored by Representatives SPIROS, SNYDER, BALLWEG, E. BROOKS, EDMING, KLEEFISCH, KRUG, KULP, MURSAU and SINICKI. Referred to Committee on Agriculture, Small Business and Tourism.

1 AN ACT *to amend* 1.10 (4); and *to create* 1.10 (3) (u) of the statutes; **relating**
2 **to:** designating ginseng as the state herb.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This bill adds state herb to the list of state symbols and designates ginseng as the state herb.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 SECTION 1. 1.10 (3) ^(v) (u) of the statutes is created to read:

4 1.10 (3) ^(v) (u) Ginseng is the state herb.

5 SECTION 2. 1.10 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

6 1.10 (4) The Wisconsin Blue Book shall include the information contained in
7 this section concerning the state song, ballad, waltz, dance, beverage, tree, grain,
8 flower, bird, fish, animal, domestic animal, wildlife animal, dog, insect, fossil,
9 mineral, rock, soil, fruit, tartan, and pastry, and herb. *and dairy product*
