To Senator Harsdorf:

This amendment conforms the language of 2017 Senate Bill 238 to the terminology change for emergency medical services personnel enacted in 2017 Wisconsin Act 12. The terminology changes in Act 12 are as follows:

<u>Before 2017 Wisconsin Act 12</u>	<u>After Act 12</u>
First responder	Emergency medical responder
Emergency medical technician (all levels collectively)	Emergency medical services practitioner
Emergency medical technician — basic	Emergency medical technician
Emergency medical technician — inter- mediate technician	Advanced emergency medical technician
Emergency medical technician — inter- mediate	Emergency medical technician — inter- mediate (same)
Emergency medical technician — para- medic	Paramedic

This amendment itself does not make substantive changes to the bill, but only substitutes the new terminology in the created text in Senate Bill 238.
