6 293.49 (1) (a) 2m. The technology that will be used at the proposed operation  
7 is capable of resulting in compliance with all applicable air, groundwater, surface  
8 water, and solid and hazardous waste management laws and rules of the department  
9 and is reasonably certain to result in compliance with these laws and rules at the  
10 proposed mining site."

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 8, line 6: after that line insert:

3 **"SECTION 1n.** 70.375 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

4 70.375 (2) (b) The secretary may promulgate any rules necessary to implement  
5 the tax under ss. 70.37 to 70.39 and 70.395 (1e). In respect to mines not in operation  
6 on November 28, 1981, ss. 71.10 (1), 71.30 (1) and (2), 71.74 (2), (3), (9), (11) and (15),  
7 71.77, 71.78, 71.80 (6), 71.83 (1) (a) 1. and 2. and (b) 2. and (2) (a) 3. and (b) 1. and  
8 71.85 (2) apply to the administration of this section."

9 **2.** Page 9, line 10: after "material" insert ", including overburden and any  
10 other material removed from any portion of the excavation site,".

11 **3.** Page 9, line 13: after "approval." insert "'Bulk sampling" shall not include  
12 such activities when the activities are, by themselves, intended for and capable of  
13 commercial exploitation of the underlying nonferrous ore body. However, the fact

1 that bulk sampling activities may have use ultimately in mining, if approved, shall  
2 not mean that bulk sampling activities constitute mining within the meaning of sub.  
3 (9), provided such activities are reasonably related to bulk sampling requirements.”

4 **4.** Page 29, line 21: after that line insert:

5 “**SECTION 35m.** 293.49 (1) (a) 2m. of the statutes is created to read:

6 293.49 (1) (a) 2m. The technology that will be used at the proposed operation  
7 is capable of resulting in compliance with all applicable air, groundwater, surface  
8 water, and solid and hazardous waste management laws and rules of the department  
9 and is reasonably certain to result in compliance with these laws and rules at the  
10 proposed mining site.”.
