**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT 3,
TO SENATE SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT 2,
TO ASSEMBLY BILL 843**

March 22, 2018 - Offered by Representatives CONSIDINE, VRUWINK, NEUBAUER, YOUNG, C. TAYLOR, SUBECK, MEYERS, POPE, HEBL, BARCA, OHNSTAD, SARGENT, BILLINGS, KOLSTE, DOYLE, SHANKLAND, SPREITZER, HINTZ and KESSLER.

1 At the locations indicated, amend the substitute amendment as follows:

2 **1.** Page 2, line 6: delete the material beginning with that line and ending with
3 line 11 and substitute:

4 **“20.255 Public instruction, department of**

5 (2) AIDS FOR LOCAL EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING

6 (dv) School safety GPR C 100,000,000 -0-

7 **SECTION 3m.** 20.255 (2) (dv) of the statutes is created to read:

8 20.255 (2) (dv) *School safety*. As a continuing appropriation, the amounts in
9 the schedule to provide grants under s. 115.337 (2).”.

10 **2.** Page 3, line 11: after that line insert:

11 **“SECTION 6q.** 115.337 of the statutes is created to read:

1 **115.337 Grants for school safety. (1) DEFINITIONS.** In this section
2 “independent charter school” means a charter school established under s. 118.40 (2r)
3 or (2x).

4 **(2) GRANTS FOR SCHOOL SAFETY.** (a) From the appropriation under s. 20.255 (2)
5 (dv), the department shall award grants for expenditures related to improving school
6 safety. The department shall accept applications for a grant under this subsection
7 from school boards, operators of independent charter schools, governing bodies of
8 private schools, and tribal schools.

9 (b) The department, in consultation with the department of justice, shall
10 develop a plan for use in awarding grants under this subsection. The department
11 shall include in the plan a description of what types of expenditures are eligible to
12 be funded by grant proceeds. Eligible expenditures shall include expenditures to
13 comply with the model practices created in s. 165.28 (1); expenditures for training
14 under s. 165.28 (3); expenditures for safety-related upgrades to school buildings,
15 equipment, and facilities; and expenditures necessary to comply with s. 118.07 (4)
16 (cf). Eligible expenditures may not include promotional materials. Notwithstanding
17 s. 227.10 (1), the plan need not be promulgated as rules under ch. 227.

18 **(3) APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS.** An application submitted for a grant under sub.
19 (2) shall include all of the following:

20 (a) A school safety plan.

21 (b) Blueprints of each school building and facility or, if blueprints were already
22 submitted, a certification that the blueprints submitted are current.

23 (c) A proposed plan of expenditure of the grant moneys.

1 **(4) REPORT.** The department shall submit an annual report to the
2 cochairpersons of the joint committee on finance providing an account of the grants
3 awarded under sub. (2) and the expenditures made with the grant moneys.”.

4 **3.** Page 7, line 19: after that line insert:

5 **“SECTION 19g.** 118.40 (2r) (e) 2p. a. of the statutes, as affected by 2017
6 Wisconsin Act 59, is amended to read:

7 118.40 **(2r)** (e) 2p. a. Add the amounts appropriated in the current fiscal year
8 under s. 20.255 (2), except s. 20.255 (2) (ac), (aw), (az), (bb), (dg), (dj), (dv), (fm), (fp),
9 (fq), (fr), (fu), (k), and (m); and s. 20.505 (4) (es); and the amount, as determined by
10 the secretary of administration, of the appropriation under s. 20.505 (4) (s) allocated
11 for payments to telecommunications providers under contracts with school districts
12 and cooperative educational service agencies under s. 16.971 (13), for grants to school
13 district consortia under s. 16.997 (7), and to make educational technology teacher
14 training grants under s. 16.996.

15 **SECTION 19gg.** 119.04 (1) of the statutes, as affected by 2017 Wisconsin Act 59,
16 is amended to read:

17 119.04 **(1)** Subchapters IV, V and VII of ch. 115, ch. 121 and ss. 66.0235 (3) (c),
18 66.0603 (1m) to (3), 115.01 (1) and (2), 115.28, 115.31, 115.33, 115.337, 115.34,
19 115.343, 115.345, 115.363, 115.364, 115.365 (3), 115.367, 115.38 (2), 115.415, 115.445,
20 118.001 to 118.04, 118.045, 118.06, 118.07, 118.075, 118.076, 118.10, 118.12, 118.125
21 to 118.14, 118.145 (4), 118.15, 118.153, 118.16, 118.162, 118.163, 118.164, 118.18,
22 118.19, 118.196, 118.20, 118.223, 118.225, 118.24 (1), (2) (c) to (f), (6), (8), and (10),

1 120.125, 120.13 (1), (2) (b) to (g), (3), (14), (17) to (19), (26), (34), (35), (37), (37m), (38),
2 and (39), 120.137, 120.14, 120.20, 120.21 (3), and 120.25 are applicable to a 1st class
3 city school district and board but not, unless explicitly provided in this chapter or in
4 the terms of a contract, to the commissioner or to any school transferred to an
5 opportunity schools and partnership program.”.

6 **4.** Page 10, line 13: delete “s. 165.88 (2) (b)” and substitute “s. 115.337 (2) (b)”.

7 **5.** Page 10, line 15: delete the material beginning with that line and ending
8 with page 11, line 20.
